



Guidelines for The Everett Dobson Award

Name of Award	This Award is named The Everett Dobson Award in honor of Everett Dobson, the inspiration and moving force behind the establishment of the Oklahoma Golf Hall of Fame (OGHOF).
Purpose	Recognize selected college graduates whose college and college golf careers have exemplified the personality traits engendered by the game of golf; to wit: citizenship, sportsmanship and character.
Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Graduate of a 4-year Oklahoma college/university (herein a “college”) b) Member of college golf team c) Graduation date within the twelve month period ending the September 1 immediately preceding the annual OGHOF awards banquet d) Selected candidates may be requested to complete personal data and background information as a condition for consideration
Selection Committee	This Award program shall be administered by the Scholarship Committee (the “Committee”) of OGHOF.
Development of Candidate List	<p>In May of each year the Committee will notify the College golf coaches that nominations for the Award will be considered and such nominations should be completed (on a form to be developed by the Committee) and returned to the Committee not later than June 25.</p> <p>Nominations may be submitted by persons other than College golf coaches, so the Committee should feel free to send notices of nomination to others.</p> <p>It is contemplated that, depending on the circumstances, the Committee could select more than one recipient in a given year and there may be a year(s) when the Committee does not recommend any Award be made.</p>
Award Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Citizenship, Sportsmanship and Character b) Golf performance, skill, etc., may be considered, but it will not be the sole or dominant determinative factor.
Nature of Award	\$5,000.00 Cash
Award Administration	<p>The Award shall be managed and administered by the Committee.</p> <p>All questions regarding the Award, its related rules of procedure and operation, and matters of interpretation and/or application shall be within the sole discretion of the Committee. All determinations of the Committee shall be final.</p>
